British Values

A while ago in the newsletter we focussed on democracy. This time we will explain a little more about how we promote "The Rule of Law". We do this through a number of ways:

- we ensure that children understand their own and others' behaviour and consequences, and learn to distinguish right from wrong
- pupils and staff collaborate together to create the rules and the codes of behaviour, for example,
 to agree the rules for playtimes and ensure that all children understand rules apply to everyone
- pupils are expected to keep class and school rules that aim to keep everyone safe, maintain good order, enable learning to take place, and to be fair.
- visits from the local police help children understand the importance of keeping the law and help to educate them about their responsibilities as citizens
- cycling Proficiency helps pupils to understand parts of Highway Code and the importance of following rules, guidelines and being safe.
- upper K5 2 pupils are encouraged to develop and understand the role of parliament and knowledge of MP's
- pupils are expected to stick to the rules of a game and obey the umpire during sporting events
- pupils are made aware of internet safety
