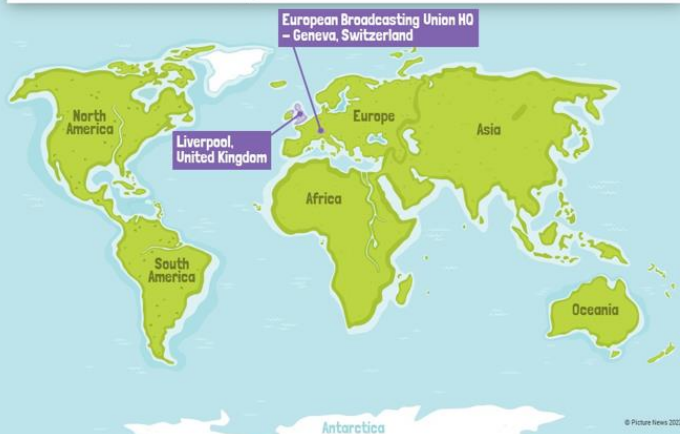


Let's look at this week's story

The city of Liverpool will be hosting this year's event and it's thought that more than 160 million people will be watching!

Participate

To take part in something.
Over 40 countries now often **participate**.

Represent

To speak, act, or be present officially on behalf of your country.
