#### Free School Meals

If you think that your child is entitled to free school meals, please visit the online portal for parents at <a href="http://www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/education-and-learning/school-transport-and-free-school-meals/">http://www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/education-and-learning/school-transport-and-free-school-meals/</a>

Here your eligibility will be checked and it will let you know if you qualify.

For every child that is entitled to free school meals the school receives extra funding to enhance provision and improve progress and outcomes for children. So please apply even if you do not wish your child to take up their free school meal.

Children are entitled to free school meals in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. You do not have to apply for free school meals if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 but if you are on low income you should still apply so that your child can claim Pupil Premium . This is extra money paid direct to schools for each child who is eligible for free school meals due to the household being on a low income. It is used to support your child's education.

#### Attendance

Parents are responsible for making sure their children attend school regularly and on time.

#### What is an authorised absence?

Only a school can authorise an absence. If your child is ill or cannot go to school for some reason, you need to contact the school by telephone and/or by letter to tell them. The school will then decide whether to authorise the absence.

There are only a few valid reasons why your child should be absent. If your child has been away from school without you giving any reason, the school will contact you to find out why. This may be by phone or letter or an invitation to a meeting in school.

#### Holidays in term time

Time off school for family holidays is **not a right**. Schools have discretion in 'exceptional circumstance' to authorise a holiday if they believe it is a genuine reason.

Due to a high occurrence of children taking holidays in term time we are in discussion with the local authority with regards to our cause of action for example; fixed penalty fines.

Please ensure your child is in school unless there is a genuine reason for absence.
