Parent Pay Debts

We have a large number of debts owed for Swimming on parent pay. Please make payment asap or we will have to review our Swimming provision and only offer the chance to go swimming once every few years for upper KS2 children. This would be detrimental as swimming is a life long skill which could save lives.

We have over £1000 of debts owed to the school for other trips/activities on parent pay at the moment. The school budget is tight and we cannot afford to subsidise this. Losing money will impact on other areas and directly impact on the children.

Update on teacher strikes

As you may be aware there are planned teachers strikes on the following dates: Wednesday 1st Feb, Thursday 2nd March, Wednesday 15th March and Thursday 16th March. We are in communication with teachers and the DfE to ensure all the relevant guidance is forwarded. As of yet we do not know the true impact on the strikes on teachers, classes or the whole school. Once we have this information we will let you know. It might be worth thiking about what you intend to do with your children should there be staff shortages and class/school closures. We will update you asap.

Class Dojo


If you haven't already signed up to Class Dojo, please do! This is a really good app to find out what your child has been learning in class and for class reminders.







Stem Workshop—Year 5


This week the year 5 pupils took part in a stem workshop as part of the K'nex challenge. Below are some photos of the pupils hard at work!





