We hope you have had a lovely, fun filled summer!

Maths – This term we will be covering Place Value and Addition and Subtraction units. The children will be working to extend their fluency, reasoning and problem solving skills.

English – This term, the children will be exploring and basing their writing around quality texts including 'Arthur and the Golden Rope' by Joe Todd-Stanton.

Times tables and number facts – Children need to have quick recall of multiplication and division facts for the 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 times tables. TTRS is a great way to practice these at home. Your child's logins will be included in this pack.

Reading – We expect children to read their levelled reading book at least four times a week at home. Please try to use the guided reading question prompt bookmark that will be sent home in your child's reading record. It is great to aim to ask at least one question for each page of text your child reads. Please sign and comment in their reading records when you listen to them read.

Spelling – Pupils will learn new spelling patterns in class each week and practise them regularly. Please can you continue to practise these with your child at home (a spelling list will be sent home with your child in their homework file).

Science -This term the children will be learning about 'States of Matter' - please see attached

Homework

Year 4's homework will be set on a Monday and due in the following Monday.
