#### Science Week

Science week began with a visit to years 5 and 6 from a civil engineer who introduced the children to what her job entails and the difficulties faced by engineers when constructing buildings that are up to 25 stories high.

On Wednesday, the whole school worked in small house groups from reception to year 6 to design and make a carrier and a parachute to protect an egg when dropped from the top of a ladder by Miss Peart. Points were awarded to each team for teamwork, 5 points were awarded if the egg cracked and 10 points were awarded if the egg remained intact. In a very close competition Woodpeckers won with 55 points, second place went to Robins with 52 points and Kingfisher and Goldfinch were joint third with 50 points. The children all enjoyed the day and worked well in their groups.

On Thursday, years 3-6 enjoyed a rocks and fossils workshop, getting to look down microscopes at a variety of rocks and fossils and getting outside to learn about the materials that were used to build the school.

Chestnut class have been carrying out an experiment to investigate the effect of a number of liquids on eggshells as well as looking at whether the use of toothpaste reduces the effect. The children and Miss Abbott will all be glad when the smelly eggs have been disposed of!
