Sessions start from 8 a.m. till 5 p.m. each day and is open to ages 5-14 years.

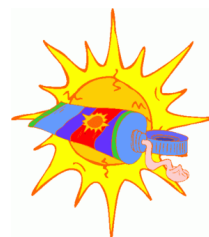
Sessions include breakfast, hot meal lunch and snacks.
